SECTION-1: Background:

Educo is a global development NGO with over 25 years' experience acting in favor of children and in defense of their rights. It has been working in Bangladesh since 1999. It gives emphasis on the quality education of the children with integration of health, livelihood and protection initiatives. We currently have geographical presence in 14 thanas/Upazila in 5 districts of the Dhaka Division: Dhaka, Narayanganj, Gazipur in Dhaka division, Mymensingh in Mymensingh Division and Moulvibazar in Sylhet division. Through our programs we reach 17,000 children, 16,000 families/ households, 21 local government institutions and 34,000 community people.

Educo and ChildFund Korea designed innovative project named-**Options for Dignity of Human** being by Influencing Key Actors to Reform (**ODHIKAR**) to have a greater impact in reduction of child labour in Dhaka city as well in the nation. We envision the implementation of this first pilot project starting from **February 2018** in collaboration with local partners.

- Knowledge of the guiding principles of the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC), initiatives taken by government of Bangladesh to comply the principles of UNCRC, legislation and policies of Bangladesh in terms of child rights
- Experience and knowledge on different policies and guideline for development and child rights in Bangladesh and global.
- Strong governance structure with the organisation with ability to adapt relevant changes as intervention demand
- Established organogram with required human resources
- At least 5-6 years' experience in similar aspects, committed to eliminate child labour.
- Past experience in implementing projects of different donors
- Experience of working and in collaboration with government at various levels, operational in Educo's program areas, member of child-right networks/coalitions/forums.
- Working experience in urban area, especially in Dhaka city
- Have all relevant policy, procedures and manual in place (e.g. Financial, Admin, HR, IT, Gender, Child Protection etc.)
- Good financial compliance, audit with good administration
- Good technical expertise in M&E along with documenting lessons learnt and good practices, as well as look for evidence of innovative approaches and able to generate knowledge.

Educo will make a short list of interested applicants after assessing according to information submitted. Educo will communicate and conduct full assessment with potential applicants including face to face interview.
