

For Hiring a Consultant to Produce a Booklet on Stories from the Photovoice Initiative and School-based Essay Writing Competitions for Bangladesh Red Crescent Society

BACKGROUND

The Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BDRCS) is an auxiliary organization to the Government of Bangladesh that aims to alleviate human suffering, promote community resilience, and enhance social cohesion. BDRCS was constituted on 31 March 1973 by the President's Order No.26 of 1973 with retrospective effect from the 16th of December 1971. The Society was recognized by the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) on 20 September 1973 and admitted to the International Federation of Red Cross (IFRC) and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC) on 02 November 1973. The Swedish Red Cross (SweRC) collaboration with the BDRCS goes back to the early 1970s. From the 1970s, the SweRC has continuously maintained its partnership with the BDRCS, mainly through multilateral support.

Since May 2022, ECHO-funded Pilot Programmatic Partnership Project (PPP) interventions in Bangladesh have been carried out under three pillars of the Pilot Programmatic Partnership and initially planned to be carried out for three years.

Considering the overall situation and humanitarian needs in the country as well as the role, capacity, and scope of BDRCS and partners, the Pilot Programmatic Partnership (PPP) project covers three pillars Disaster Risk Management (DRM) (technical support from German Red Cross), Epidemic and Pandemic Preparedness and Response (EPPR) (technical support form Danish Red Cross), and Risk Communication, Community Engagement & Accountability (CEA) (Technical support from Swedish Red Cross).

The main purpose of this assignment is to support Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BDRCS) to curate and produce a booklet showcasing stories collected from the PPP Photovoice Initiative and School-based Essay Writing Competitions. The booklet aims to highlight the voices and experiences of participants, capturing their narratives on how PPP activities are bringing changes in the community in both Bangla and English. The booklet will consist of a maximum of 20 stories accompanied by color pictures, presented in a visually appealing and engaging format (around 40 pages).

OBJECTIVES OF THE ASSIGNMENT

The consultant is expected to undertake the following specific duties:

- Compile a selection of compelling stories from the Photovoice Initiative and School-based Essay Writing Competitions.
- Create a bilingual booklet in Bangla and English, with each story presented in both languages.
- Design the booklet with colorful illustrations to enhance the storytelling experience.
- Produce a print-ready version of the booklet for future printing and physical distribution (in CMYK).













Develop an e-book version of the booklet that can be downloaded and accessed online (in RGB).

SCOPE OF WORK

The consultant's responsibilities will include, but are not limited to:

- Reviewing and selecting stories from the submissions of the Photovoice Initiative and Schoolbased Essay Writing Competitions.
- Obtaining necessary permissions and clearances for the publication of selected stories and accompanying photographs.
- Language Stream selected stories into both Bangla and English as necessary.
- Preparing a compelling and appropriate booklet cover with beautiful illustrations.
- Designing the layout of the booklet, incorporating color pictures and illustrations.
- Preparing a concise and attractive preface and an accessible table of contents
- Adding a postface (at the end of the book) describing more about PPP and the CEA pillar and sharing some hotline numbers in a compelling manner
- Ensuring that the booklet complies with printing standards and specifications for high-quality output.
- Reviewing and proofreading the booklet ensuring it is free of grammatical errors and consists
 of accurate information
- Creating an e-book version of the booklet compatible with online platforms for easy access and download.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Consultant will be sharing these Deliverables:

- Inception Report
- A curated selection of 20 stories, translated into Bangla and English.
- A visually appealing booklet layout with colorful illustrations, ready for printing.
- A print-ready version of the booklet in PDF format (in CMYK).
- An e-book version of the booklet in a downloadable format suitable for online distribution (in RGB).
- All necessary files and materials related to the production of the booklet.

- Strong graphic design skills and proficiency in layout software (e.g., Adobe InDesign).
- Familiarity with printing standards and requirements for high-quality production.
- Ability to create accessible and user-friendly e-book formats for online distribution.
- Able to work in a multi-cultural team environment.
- Displays cultural, gender, religion, race, nationality, age sensitivity and adaptability.

EVALUATION/SELECTION PROCESS

All applicants will be screened against the plan and qualifications and competencies set above. Candidates fully meeting the requirements will be further evaluated based on the criteria below.

- CV review, experience qualifications as defined in the ToR. The highest relevant year of experience will get the highest score (20)
- Least 3 examples of previous works like this assignment should be demonstrated (20)
 - 1-2 POs/Contracts of any organization will get 5 points
 - 3-4 POs/Contracts of any organization will get 10 points
 - 5-6 POs/Contracts of any organization will get 15 points
 - Above 6 POs/Contracts of any organization will get 20 points
- Lead time will be evaluated inverse proportion method, which means the lowest budget will get the highest score (20).
- The technical proposal and plan will be critically evaluated; the highest score is 40. It will also depend on the relevant, appropriate quoted costing.
