BACKGROUND

Under the pillar of Economic Justice and Resilience, Oxfam in Bangladesh is implementing the Empower Youth for Work (EYW) Project. It is a 5-year project being funded by IKEA Foundation and implemented in Bangladesh, Pakistan, Indonesia and Ethiopia. The overall aim of the EYW programme in Bangladesh is improved economic and social empowerment for young women and men living in rural climate-change affected areas.

The target group of the project consists of young women and men, community members, policy makers, government representatives and private sectors actors. The main target group is young women and men of aged 15-29 residing in rural climate vulnerable areas. The geographic locations of the project in Bangladesh are: Mithapukur upzilla under Rangpur district, Puthia upzilla under Rajshahi district, Botiaghata upzilla under Khulna district and Bakerganj upzilla under Barisal district. The project aims to provide support to 67,000 direct beneficiaries, focusing on women from targeted townships and communities in Bangladesh to improve their economic and social resilience to climate extremes.

The Empower Youth for Work (EYW) team comprise of Oxfam staff and partners of four countries and Oxfam Novib will come together in November 2017 in Bangladesh for the first annual learning event. This learning event will be organized to provide an opportunity for sharing and learning on the EYW project and identify paths for better, more collaborative and more impactful programming.
