This includes line management of the key Technical Specialists as well as ensuring that programmes are implemented, managed and budgeted to meet with donor compliance and the needs of the community and children. Work closely with the EiE Response team to ensure project planning, reporting, implementation and monitoring, evaluation and accountability are in place for the Plan International Bangladesh EiE Response.

Fundraising and Advocacy:

 Identify learning and training opportunities for Plan International Bangladesh staff and partners and support and build the capacity of less experienced staff around programme management.

Team Management:

Line manage and support the overall EiE Team in the fulfillment of performance management, addressing issues within the team, and support key development areas for the Technical Specialists and field officers.

Position Qualification, experience and competencies

University degree preferably in Education, Social Sciences or related field with 5 years' experience in Programme Management, International refugee Education, Human rights and Humanitarian law.

- Experience in a humanitarian setting will be an asset. Experience of working in emergency response managing Education portfolios is a plus.
- Good knowledge and understanding of DO NO HARM principles and established education in emergencies standards.
- Demonstrates awareness and sensitivity to gender and diversity. Have experience and the ability to live and work in diverse cultural contexts in a culturally appropriate manner.
- Has a capacity to make accurate self-assessment particularly in high stress and high security contexts.
- Ability to operate effectively under extreme circumstances including stress, high security risks and harsh living conditions. Works and lives with a flexible, adaptable and resilient manner.
- Well-developed written and oral communication skills. Able to communicate clearly and sensitively with internal and external stakeholders as a representative of the organization.
- Fluency in English both written and oral is required.

Technical Competencies required for this position are
