To produce a web-based database for AIN-ALAP unit of Bandhu

Section -1: Background

Bandhu Social Welfare Society (Bandhu) started its journey in 1996 aiming to work for the welfare of the gender-diverse population in Bangladesh where every person, regardless of their gender and sexuality, is able to lead a quality life with dignity, human rights, and social justice. Bandhu launched a project in February 2022 titled "Building Access to Justice and Legal Support for Gender Diverse Population of Bangladesh" funded by UNDEF. The major objective of this project is to understand the knowledge, attitudes, practices, perceptions, experiences, and behaviors toward Human Rights, Rule of Law, and Access to Justice among the TG and Hijra communities. Gender Diverse Population (GDP) particularly the Transgender (TG) and Hijra community are stigmatized and victimized in our country. However, to ensure the legal services to the gender diverse community, Bandhu established a legal helpline service titled Ain-Alap in 2013 for addressing the legal issues and served the community through a dedicated legal helpline number since the beginning. Ain Alap also refers to other legal service-providing organizations in Bangladesh where needed Over the years Bandhu's Legal Help Unit (AIN ALAP) has recorded an alarming number of Sexual and Gender Based Violence cases. GDP population also encounter unlawful arrest by Law Enforcement Agencies. Bandhu has a proven track record in working with NLASO, DLAC and other legal service-providing organizations. A strong network through Bandhu Panel Lawyers, Watchdog members, and different stakeholders.

To provide the Ain Alap services to the community, Bandhu developed a database in Excel and using it for record and reporting purpose. Therefore, Bandhu decided to uphold its services by systematic management of records of cases of Ain Alap. Improving the data management system is important for effective case tracking and analysis to provide better insights for project management and decision-making. The development of user friendly web-based software is essential nowadays. The database software should reflect all data and reports.
