Role definition

Role purpose

Christian Aid Bangladesh has been granted the Natural Resources Management Project this year under WFP's Resilience programs in Cox's Bazar. To emphasize a localization strategy, Christian Aid is adopting a partnership approach with Gana Unnayan Kendra (GUK) for this project.

The Project Manager is tasked with ensuring the timely execution of project activities in designated camps and host communities, adhering to humanitarian principles and sector guidelines. Responsibilities include data collection, maintenance for regular reporting, and addressing challenges to ensure a swift, effective, and timely response, holding overall responsibility for project achievements and outcomes.

Key responsibilities/outcomes

- Responsible for the implementation of Natural Resources Management project under resilience programs through partnership approach in camps and host areas
- Monitor and guide the implementing partner GUK on effective implementation of the project activities and support at every stages as and where needed
- Follow the targets of the project from WFP and coordinate with GUK team for the timely achievement of the targets
- Coordinate and support the GUK team to prepare the contingency plan considering the emergency preparedness and response activities throughout the project tenure
- Support the GUK team to undertake need assessment to the donors and finalize the activities/schemes to be undertaken in the project after approval of RRRC office
- Ensure the work plan is closely followed up for timely implementation of the project activities.
- Regular financial monitoring of the project to ensure effective utilization of the budget and coordinate and guide GUK to move forward with the same or changed plan.



- Supporting the MEAL team to have a robust monitoring and evaluation operational plan and ensuring of the project activates, it's implementation of monitoring activities.
- Together with the team ensure the project activities in line with the humanitarian standards and sectoral guidelines.
- Regular update the project progress and challenges to the senior management of CA and ensure timely resolving of the challenges. Assist to resolve the challenges of GUK on project implementation and reach out to management where needed
- Effectively communicating with WFP related to the project and provide all required information on time.
- Keep track of all donor compliance requirements and ensure adherence.
- Ensure that adequate staffing is in place for the activities, including an appropriate gender balance within the working group. Ensure all staff are trained on the skills and values required.

Works closely with staff across CA on humanitarian and resilience issues, in particular staff working on natural resources management and structural mitigation works.
