For

Individual Consultant to Provide Technical Assistance in Establishing Fair Price Shop and Nutritious and Safe Food Supply Chain in Ready-Made Garment (RMG) Factory

### **Organization Background:**

The Global Alliance for Improved Nutrition (GAIN) is a Swiss-based foundation launched at the UN in 2002 to tackle the human suffering caused by malnutrition. Working with both governments and businesses, we aim to transform food systems so that they deliver more nutritious food for all people. We aim to make healthier food choices more desirable, more available, and more affordable. GAIN's purpose is to advance nutrition outcomes by improving the consumption of nutritious and safe food for all people, especially the most vulnerable to malnutrition. GAIN has a proven record of facilitating practical solutions that increase the nutritional value and safety of foods in ways that work for consumers, businesses, and governments. ### Project background:

Ready-Made Garment (RMG) sector employs more than 3.5 million workers, contributing 82% of the total export income. Nutrition plays a vital role in improving the well-being and productivity of workers. This translates into economic growth as well as greater motivation for the workers. According to the study by the International Labour Office (ILO), inadequate nourishment can cut productivity by up to 20%. In Bangladesh, 43% of the female garment workers are chronically malnourished. It is explicit that inadequate, poor-quality diet and hygiene practice can lead to malnutrition, diseases, and lower work performance. GAIN implements a workforce nutrition project named "Strengthening Workers' Access to Pertinent Nutrition Opportunities (SWAPNO)" in partnership with VF Corporation. It aims to contribute to a healthier and more productive workforce by improving the diet for garment workers and improve knowledge around nutritious and safe foods for themselves. Project reach is around 25,000 workers and requires a coordinated work of various partners and factory management. The objective of the project will be achieved through two sets of interrelated and reinforcing outputs: i) RMG workers in VF supported factories have improved knowledge around nutritious and safe foods for themselves, and ii) RMG workers in the VF supported factories have improved access to nutritious and safe foods either through improved lunches or through fair price shops which offer nutritious and safe foods. The enduring vision of the project is to enable businesses to create a culture of commitment and benefits workers through the consumption of safe and nutritious food contributing to their overall wellbeing. Generating concrete evidence to make a positive influence on the factories to invest in their workers' diets will eventually help factories to be more productive and strengthen the reputation of their business.

## **Objectives of the Consultancy**

The primary objective of the consultancy is to design a scalable and sustainable model for the FPS (operate by the factory and operate by the third party) and cost-effective supply chain for nutritious and safe food items/products for the RMG workers including operation, monitoring, and reporting system.

#### **Timeframe**

The proposed timeframe for the activity will be from 15 December 2020 to 30 March 2021

### **Mode of Payment:**

#### Selection benchmark:

The consultant will be selected based on technical experience. Shortlisted candidates will have an offline/online meeting with respective persons of GAIN. The consultant will be selected based on technical experience and oral presentation and asking budget.

### The Consultant will be selected based on the following criteria:

- 1. At least 5 years of continuous professional experience in the development sector to promote the private sector by designing a potential business approach.
- 2. Relevant skills and ability to design innovative business approaches use participatory tools, RMG workers, and market-related data collection and analysis.
- 3. Familiarity with the supply chain and market-related issues for safe and nutritious food
- 4. Have strong capacities of standard report writing in English
- 5. Cultural sensitivity and respect for others opinion
- 6. Ability and mentality to work in a private sector
